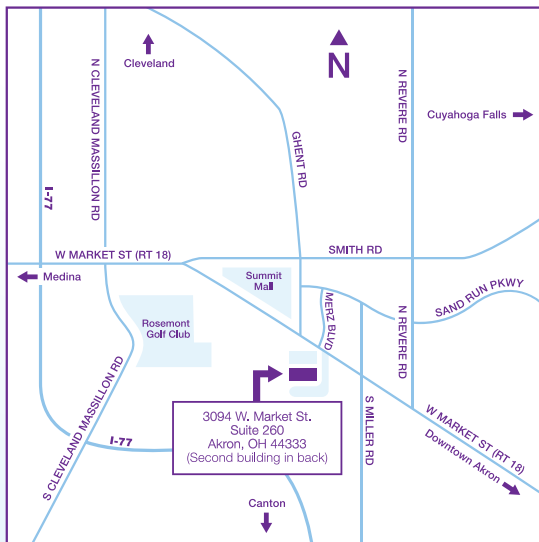

## Who We Are

### Dr. John Gerstenmaier

Dr. John Gerstenmaier received his bachelor's degree from Case Western Reserve University (CWRU) and attended Northwestern University Dental School. After graduating, Dr. John worked for the Indian Health Service — a U.S. Department of Health and Human Services agency that provides healthcare to Native American and Alaskan Native peoples. During that time, he quickly began to make connections that would shape the foundations for his own practice.

After spending two years treating children in the Indian Health Service, Dr. John decided the time had come for him to pursue further education in pediatric dentistry. He completed a 2-year program at CWRU, and in 1975, founded Gerstenmaier Pediatric Dentistry.

### Dr. Jack Gerstenmaier

After graduating from the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, Massachusetts, Jack Gerstenmaier began working for SRU Biosystems, Inc. But after four and a half years, he began to feel the need for something more meaningful. Dr. Jack previously helped his father on the weekends as a dental assistant. He quickly realized there had to be something satisfying about the field of dentistry for his father to be practicing for so long.
